ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATION

1. Applicant must be a high school senior currently enrolled in a St. Louis Public High School.

2. Applicant must be planning to enroll in a 2 or 4 year college.

Screening guidelines are as follows:

Applicant will be considered on the basis of academic achievement, financial need and potential.

1. Students who have completed all parts of the application
2. Students who have at least a 2.75 G.P.A.
3. Students who have at least a score of 20 on the ACT
4. Students who are actively engaged in the community.

In order to qualify for scholarship renewal, students must provide an official college transcript every year showing a G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher. Upon receipt of this transcript, a check will be issued for the following school year.
